



Somali Christian Media Ministries



They discuss topics that are relevant to Somalis such as the ‘shame culture’; and recent events such as the terrorist attacks in Nice. This has gathered a lot of interest from Somali English-speaking people who may be interested to hear a non-Muslim perspective on Somali topics, especially 2nd generation Somalis. These podcasts are made on a weekly basis and have been popular.
