Our evening services will be on zoom. Church family members should have received the link by email (it will be the same link each week) If you have not received this, please contact the office & we will send it to you.



But we have a God who wants us to bring everything to him in prayer. (Philippians 4:6-7) Our fears, struggles and disappointments, as well as our hopes and dreams. Every detail is precious to God, and by bringing it all before him in prayer, we don't have to hide away parts of ourselves.

We're able to be real and authentic with God. And through this we're able to continue to process the hurt we're feeling, while understanding the truth that God is in control and will continue to move in miraculous ways this next year.
